On April 14, 2021, at approximately 0113 hours, I, Ofc. Waite, was dispatched to VIP Gentleman's Club, located at 1221 Duval Street, in reference to a male subject refusing to leave the premises. On arrival, I observed a white male, identified later as Joseph Ayers, standing on the sidewalk directly in front of the business. Several female employees of VIP Gentleman's Club were standing on the front porch of the business.

The caller, identified later as Courtney Shaw, informed Ofc. Litton that she had asked Ayers to leave the property approximately thirty minutes prior to calling for Police. Shaw also added that she asked Ayers to leave approximately ten times and he continuously refused. Another female stated that Ayers had walked behind the front desk and began looking through its contents. While Ofc. Litton spoke to the females, Ayers continuously interrupted their conversation by shouting and talking through them. Due to Ayers' belligerent behavior, I asked him to walk a short distance away from the business to speak with me.

I recommended to Ayers that he return to his hotel room for the evening. This was in an attempt to prevent any further calls from the business in the instance that Ayers remained in the area after we left. Ayers refused to leave and sarcastically stated "I'm resting". It was very apparent that Ayers was intoxicated and the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanated from his breath as he spoke. I strongly urged Ayers to vacate the area for the evening and even offered to give him a ride back to his hotel room. Ayers declined my offer and told me he was not breaking any laws by standing on the sidewalk in front of the business. I ended my encounter with Ayers and began walking to my patrol vehicle. While returning to my patrol vehicle, Ayers shouted "Go find something better to do!". As I unlocked my patrol vehicle, which was parked across the street from the business, I heard Ayers confront Ofc. Litton who had decided to remain near the business in an attempt to deter any further altercation.

I returned to Ofc. Litton. Ofc. Litton was issuing Ayers a trespass warning on behalf of the business. Ayers loudly and belligerently argued the legality of the trespass warning, claiming that the establishment was a "public business". As Ayer's argued with Ofc. Litton, I observed several passersby in the area uncomfortably walk past the business. I also observed three subjects standing on the front porch of a residence across the street. All three individuals were very curiously watching our encounter with Ayers and appeared to be intrigued by the commotion Ayers was causing. I walked across the street and spoke with a male subject, identified later as Nick Brinkley, who was on the front porch of the residence. Brinkley told me he could hear the commotion from his residence and described Ayers as a "drunk idiot". I returned to VIP Gentleman's Club and spoke with an employee who would only identify herself as "Diamond". Diamond told me that Ayers was making her very uncomfortable and deterring potential customers from entering the business.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, my conversation with Brinkley and Diamond, and the fact that Ayers was now disrupting the peace and quiet of the neighborhood, I approached Ayers and asked him to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Ayers verbally and physically refused. I unholstered my department issued OC spray and displayed it for Ayers. Again, I asked Ayers to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Ayers continuously refused to verbally and physically respond to my requests. In total, Ayers was asked six times to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Due to the passive resistance displayed by Ayers, I issued two bursts of OC Spray from my canister. The bursts struck Ayers in his face and neck. Ayers turned away from me and began walking south on Duval Street. This was a physically evasive movement made by Ayers to defeat our attempts of taking him into custody. Ofc. Litton and I grabbed a hold of Ayers and placed him into handcuffs. I notified Communications that Ayers had been sprayed and requested that Rescue respond to my location. Sgt. Kouri heard my transmission and responded to the scene. Key West Fire Department Rescue 2 also responded to the scene to treat Ayers. After receiving treatment from Rescue 2, I placed Ayers into the rear of my patrol vehicle. Ayers was transferred to the

On 04/14/2021 at approximately 0100 hours, Officer K. Waite and I (Ofc. A. Litton) were dispatched to the VIP Gentleman's Club, 1221 Duval Street, in reference to a disruptive customer outside the business.

When I arrived, the subject described as a male wearing a black t-shirt was standing outside, leaning against the VIP Gentleman's Club's vehicle. I could hear the employees asking the male to leave, but he continued to argue as he leaned against their vehicle. I asked the subject for his ID but he refused. The subject continued to argue and deny any form of identification as I explained he was going to be issued a trespass warning for the VIP Gentleman's Club. I then asked the subject for his name who simply stated "Joe Shmo." I then realized I recognized the subject from a report I took on 04/12/2021. I checked my computer and identified him as Joseph Ayers from a criminal mischief report I took for him. As with my previous encounter with Ayers, he appeared intoxicated with a heavy slur in his speech and an odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his breath as he spoke.

I spoke with the reporting party, Courtney Shaw, who explained Ayers was inside the business for approximately 30 minutes. During that time, Ayers was behind the front desk rummaging through the drawers of the business' welcome desk without anybody's permission. Shaw stated she asked Ayers to leave about 10 times as he continuously refused. Since Ayers was off the property and leaning on the business' vehicle as I arrived, I asked the employees if, aside from standing on the sidewalk, if Ayers was doing anything else? Shaw said he was just leaning against their car being loud and obnoxious, scaring off other customers.

I had Ayers information from a previous call and issued him a trespass warning. Ayers continuously argued with me about the trespass warning's legality arguing it was a public business and he was allowed to enter the premise. Ayers then informed me his phone was inside the business. I asked the employees to verify this who affirmed they allowed Ayers to search for his phone inside. They also stated they helped him search for his phone which was never located. I went back and told Ayers his phone was not inside the business which he now acknowledged he already knew.

Ayers became continuously loud, argumentative and insulting during our encounter. After explaining the trespass warning and seeing Ayers' obvious defiance of any warnings, I remained on scene to assure he did not enter the premise again. Ayers then resorted to insults as he still refused to disengage and walk away.

After speaking with numerous bystanders about Ayers disruptive behavior, Officer K. Waite told Ayers to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Officer K. Waite repeated himself two more times as Ayers continued to verbally and physically refused. Officer K. Waite then displayed his department issued OC spray and again told Ayers to turn around and place his hands behind his back. Ayers continued to defy the commands given and was informed that he would be pepper sprayed if he continued to resist. Ayers still refused when Officer K. Waite deployed two bursts of OC spray from his canister.

The bursts struck Ayers in the head and neck. Some of the spray splashed off Ayers and, because I was downwind, I was struck in the face with the OC spray. Ayers turned away and began walking South on Duval Street. Officer K. Waite and I followed Ayers, took ahold of each of his arms and I placed him in handcuffs. Officer K. Waite notified dispatch of the OC spray deployment and Key West Rescue 2 responded to the scene to treat Ayers. Sergeant D. Kouri also responded to the scene to document the use of force and photograph my exposure to the OC spray, as well. Officer K. Waite transported Ayers to MCDC, which concluded my involvement in this case.
