Re: May Monthly Report for Key West Historic Seaport

## **Key West Bight Operations:**

• Ferry Terminal Gate 1 double doors scheduled for replacement.

- Trumbo Road Floating Docks project anticipated to be completed by end of May. Contractor waiting on final utility permits
- Contractor will mobilize to site on June 9,2021 for the 201 William Street Spalling Repair project. Heavy construction to begin last full week of June. Contractor has already spoken with tenants directly affected by the construction and additional notices will be sent out.
- Finalizing Wayfinding package. Will complete outside of Common Area Enhancements project.
- Margaret St Fire Pump Replacement project construction documents 90% complete. Waiting on final pump design to advertise.
- Bids for the CRSC Roof / Wall Cladding Replacement project open on May 5, 2021. Construction to occur in August and September.
- Preparing task order with K2M Design for final site plan and 3-D renderings for the 631 Greene St Redevelopment project.

## **Key West Bight Marina:**

- May transient dockage is up 197% mainly due to the reopening of the pandemic compared to the shut down last April.
- Fuel sales reflect the same up 690% compared to last year May.
- Likewise, dinghy slip rentals are up 88%.
- Transient slips are full, and we are predicting that it would stay that way through August unless, storm threats arise.
- Fuel systems were inspected and passed the monthly inspections. Ferry Terminal fuel pump broke down on May 6th. Pump was ordered and installation is set for June 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- 20,644 passengers passed through the ferry terminal this May compared to 15,597 last May.
