A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING SUNRISE ROTARY FOUNDATION OF KEY WEST, INC. THE USE OF CITY PROPERTY AT 1405 DUVAL STREET FOR A BREWFEST KEY WEST FESTIVAL ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 4, 2021 FROM 3:00 P.M. TO 8:00 P.M; (RAIN DATE OF SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 5, 2021); AUTHORIZING THE SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES WITHIN THE BARRICADED AREA; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, Sunrise Rotary Foundation of Key West, Inc. wishes to use the Southernmost Beach café site between the hours of 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Saturday, September 4, 2021; and

WHEREAS, this event shall take place on the grounds of the Southernmost Beach Café between the hours of 3:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Commission of the City of Key West, Florida.

SECTION 1. That in Resolution 19-174, the City Commission directed the City Manager to "develop language that restricts the use of polystyrene by individuals on public property, temporary vendors on public property, or entities engaged in a contractual relationship with the local government for the local government for the provision of good or services, unless such use is otherwise preempted by law"

SECTION 2. "That the vendor/lessee/licensee acknowledges the City's concern about the negative environmental impact of using disposable polystyrene products, which are neither readily recyclable nor biodegradable. Vendor/Lessee/licensee/contractor therefore, commits to refrain from the use of polystyrene/plastic straws, bags, plastic utensils and "to go" packages for food or products sold on any property leased from the

SECTION 3. That the Sunrise Rotary Foundation of Key West, Inc. is hereby granted permission for the use of the Southernmost Beach Cafe site on the date and during the hours stated above; PROVIDED all trash is adequately collected and contained; guarantees indemnifying the City is executed; and provided the organizations meet the terms and conditions set forth by the City Manager.

SECTION 4. That pursuant to Section 18-86 of the Key West Code of Ordinances, permission is granted to allow the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages within the enclosed area.

SECTION 5. Sunrise Rotary Foundation of Key West must post the required notice regarding prohibition of purchase and sale of alcoholic beverages to persons under 21 years of age.

SECTION 6. That the Sunrise Rotary Foundation of Key West, Inc. & Southernmost Beach Café will adhere to the recycling plan of the City of Key West, that one (1) recycling container for every one (1) trash barrels will be used and that they will be placed side by side.

SECTION 7. That the applicant acknowledges this authorization may be revoked by the Commission or the City Manager, due to exigent circumstances such as the resurgence of COVID-19 in the community.

SECTION 8. That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signatures of the presiding officer and Clerk of the Commission.
