On 05/26/2021 at approximately 0138 I was flagged down by the staff at Ricks for an unknown problem.

The bouncer Michalel Hall (later identified by a FL DL) told me that the suspect Justice Daniel Kearney (later identified by an OR DL) was attempting to fight several patrons at the bar and needed to be removed.

Kearney saw my marked Key West Patrol car and began running down the street toward Greene St. I proceeded around the corner to talk to Kearney. When I turned the corner onto Greene St. I did not see Kearney.

I was then flagged down by a patron at the Tiki House who informed me that Kearney had just ran into the bar. I exited my patrol car and attempted to enter the bar to locate Kearney. I made it to the porch of the bar when Kearney came running out of the bar directly at me. Kearney then lost his footing and fell to the ground. I attempted to restrain Kearney when he began to attempt to get up and run again. I was able to gain control of Kearney's upper torso when he put his hands under his chest to prevent me from placing him into handcuffs. Kearney then began to kick his legs up in attempt to kick me in the back.

There was a good Samaritan that was able to assist in holding down Kearney's legs, so I was able place him into handcuffs. By this time other officers arrived. All officers at the scene were wearing their KWPD class Bravo uniform and driving marked patrol cars. Kearney continued to resisting even when all other officers were attempting to restrain him. Sgt. A Rodriguez made the decision to Hobble Kearney due to him still kicking his legs and not complying with lawful commands. KWFR was dispatched to check the medical condition of Kearney due to two small abrasion to his forehead.

Once Kearney was hobbled officers attempted to place him into the back of my patrol car, he refused by tensing his legs refusing to enter car. At this point Kearney was warned if he did not comply and enter the patrol car, he would be pepper sprayed. Kearney still refused to enter the patrol car so K-9 Ofc. Hansell pepper sprayed Kearney. Sgt Rodriguez then requested KWFR back to the scene to assess Kearney and transport him to Lower Keys Medical Center for treatment and clearance.

Kearney was transported to Lower Keys Medical Center with out incident.

Kearney was cleared by the medical staff at Lower Keys Medical Center. I then Transported him to the MCDC without further incident.

Justice Daniel Kearney did knowingly and willingly commit the offense of Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer F.S 784.07-(2)(b) by kicking me in the back while attempting to detain him while conducting my duties as a Law Enforcement officer, wearing my KWPD class Bravo uniform and driving my KWPD marked patrol car.

Justice Daniel Kearney did knowingly and willingly commit the offense of Resisting officer with violence F.S 843.01 by kicking me in the back while attempting to detain him while conducting my duties as a Law Enforcement officer, wearing my KWPD class Bravo uniform and driving my KWPD marked patrol car.

Justice Daniel Kearney did knowingly and willingly commit the offense of Resisting officer without violence to his or her person F.S 843.02 by refusing to comply with lawful orders by uniformed law enforcement personal when instructed to enter the back of my patrol car, resulting in him having to be hobbled and pepper sprayed.

On 05-27-2021, I, K-9 Ofc. Matthew Hansell of the key West police Department, responded to 430 Green St. in reference to an officer needing assistance.

Officer Roscoe advised over radio that he was out with a subject and requested additional units. I then heard several radio key ups that sounded as if Ofc. Roscoe was in a struggle. Key West Channel One Dispatch advised it was from his radio and asked for officers to expedite.

I activated my emergency lights and siren and proceeded to 430 Green St. from Lime Tree Grocery. As I arrived on scene, I saw Ofc. Roscoe and Ofc. Hudson holding a white male on the ground. I ran over to Ofc. Hudson who was controlling the shoulder area of the male and he handed me an Oregon drivers license belonging to the male.

I had Key West Dispatch Channel 2 enter the license in NCIC/FCIC and he was identified as Justice Kearney. I took Hudson's spot holding Kearney down by the shoulders and making sure he was in a recovery position on his left side while on the ground.

During this time, Kearney screamed and yelled at officers about his treatment and why he was not allowed to be drunk in Key West. Kearney smelled of vomit and the strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from his person.

I told Kearney several times to relax and tried to calm him down, however he refused and kept tensing his body and trying to get up off the ground and away from officers. At one point a hobble restraint device was used to try and keep Kearney immobile for his and officers protection.

Key West Fire Rescue arrived the first time and assist Kearney, who had minor scrapes on him from flailing on the ground.

After Key West Fore Rescue left the scene myself and Ofc. Ane attempted to put Kearney into Ofc. Roscoe's patrol car.

Kearney, who was still yelling and refusing to cooperate, went limp making himself heavy and refused to stand on his own feet. Kearney was placed back on the ground, where he tensed his body up like a surf board so that we could not get him onto the patrol vehicle.

After numerous attempts, Kearney was placed back on the side walk still handcuffed and hobbled. Kearney began yelling and screaming again and forcefully trying to kick at officers. At one point Sgt. Rodriguez asked if anyone had OC spray and of course I did.

I gave Kearney several warnings to stop or he would be sprayed with OC. Kearney refused to listen to me. I sprayed a

one second burst onto the forehead of Kearney and watched as the OC rolled down into his eyes.

The OC had an initial effect as Kearney stopped yelling and struggling with officers to complaining about the OC.

Key West Fire Rescue was called back to our location as it was determined Kearney needed to go to the hospital via ambulance.

Kearney was eventually placed on a stretcher and I put a spit hood on him as he spit at officers. Once in the ambulance, I followed Key West Fire Rescue with Officer Perez on board to the ER.

I had no further contact with Kearney.

My Axon Body Camera was used during this incident.

On Thursday, May 27, 2021, at approximately 0138 hours, I, Ofc. Ane, responded to the Tiki House, 430 Greene Street, to assist Ofc. R. Roscoe with an arrestee who became combative.

Upon arrival, I saw Ofc. R. Roscoe had one person, later identified as Justice Kearney, in handcuffs. Kearney was lying on the ground, with small abrasions to his face and forehead. Kearney was still thrashing his body back and forth as officers were trying to keep him on his side to avoid any risk of positional asphyxiation. Officers attempted to calm Kearney down and reason with him, however, he continued to curse and scream at offices, while attempting to defeat our efforts to control him. Kearney began to kick his legs at officers, so I placed a hobble/restraint device over both of his feet.

KWFD Rescue 2 was called to the scene to asses and treat Kearney's injuries. KWFD Rescue 2 arrived on scene and looked at Kearney's injuries then left the scene.

Several other officers were on scene and we attempted several times to pick Kearney up and place him in the rear seat of Ofc. R. Roscoe's patrol vehicle. Each time we attempted to place Kearney in Ofc. R. Roscoe's vehicle he would make his body limp to make moving him more difficult. The few times we were able to get his feet into the vehicle, he would extend and stiffen his legs, then push his feet off of the vehicle's partition to make putting him into the seat impossible. Each time we had to place Kearney on the ground after he refused to be put into Ofc. R. Roscoe's vehicle, he would again escalate and thrash his body around to make gaining control of him more difficult.

Ofc. M. Hansell gave Kearney numerous warnings to stop resisting or he would be pepper sprayed. Kearney ignored all of Ofc. M. Hansell's warnings and he was subsequently pepper sprayed.

KWFD Rescue 2 was called back to the scene to treat Kearney. Officers struggled to put Kearney onto Rescue's stretcher. Kearney began to spit, so Ofc. M. Hansell and I placed a department issued "Spit hood" on him. KWFD Rescue 2 then transported Kearney to LKMC.

I had no further involvement with this investigation.

This investigation was recorded via my department issued body worn camera, which I later uploaded to evidence.com.

After securing Kearney's property, I assisted Officer R. Perez and Key West Rescue in putting Kearney into the ambulance.

On May 27, 2021 at approximately 0139 hours, I, Ofc. S. Ham responded to 430 Greene St. as a back up unit.

Upon arrival, Ofc. R. Roscoe had the suspect detained and laying down on the ground. There were two bystanders assisting Ofc. Roscoe with maintaining control. I asked the bystander holding the suspects feet to let go and I went to grab his legs. The suspect attempted to kick his legs upwards. I grabbed both the suspects legs and used my bodyweight to hold them down. Ofc. Roscoe and I maintained control of the suspect until the remaining back up arrived on scene.

I assisted Ofc. A. Ane with securing the suspects legs with a hobble. The suspect was able to get one of his legs out of the hobble before it was tightened. Ofc. Ane and I were able to regain control of the suspects legs and get the hobble secured.

I stepped away from the suspect to meet with the witness (Michael Hall), who was located in front of 202 Duval St. Michael filled out a Key West Police Department sworn written statement. I turned the written statement over to Ofc. Roscoe to be submitted to the KWPD records division.

My Axon BWC was activated and uploaded.

On 05/27/2021, at 0138 hours, Ofc. Roscoe called for assistance with a suspect he was having issues detaining. I (Ofc. R. Perez) responded Ofc. Roscoe's location to assist in detaining the suspect.

Upon arrival, Ofc. Ham and Ofc. Ane had a male later identified by his Oregon DL as Justice Kearney on the ground handcuffed. I began to gather information from witnesses. I spoke to a male later identified by his Florida DL as Peter Nicholsen. Nicholsen stated he was sitting in the Tiki House bar when he saw Kearney come running in, stumble over some stools and run into the women's restroom. Kearney then ran out and attempted to shoulder charge Ofc. Roscoe. Ofc. Roscoe stopped Kearney and took Kearney to the ground in a controlled manner. Ofc. Roscoe was giving Kearney loud verbal commands to place his hands behind his back, but Kearney refused. Nicholsen stated he assisted Ofc. Roscoe placing Kearney in handcuffs.

I then spoke to a female later identified by her Florida DL as Randi Barcelli. Barcelli stated she was working behind the bar at Tiki House when she noticed Kearny run into the bar knock over stools and a table and run into the women's restroom. Kearney then ran out knocked over more stools and tables and fell on the ground. He then stood up and tried to run into Ofc. Roscoe. Ofc. Roscoe grabbed Kearney and took him to the ground slowly and easily.

I gathered Barcelli's and Nicholsen's information and passed the information to Ofc. Roscoe and Sgt. A, Rodriguez.

Sgt. A. Rodriguez, Ofc. Ham and Ofc. Hudson were on the ground attempting to gain control of Kearney. I replaced Sgt. A. Rodriguez and attempted to gain control of Kearney's legs. We attempted to place Kearney in the back seat of Ofc. Roscoe's patrol vehicle but Kearney was kicking and not allowing us to place him in the vehicle. Kearny was then placed on the ground and warned that he will be OC sprayed if he did not comply with our orders. Kearney continued to resist and was OC sprayed by Ofc. M. Hansel. Rescue 2 arrived on scene and they put Kearney on their stretcher. Ofc. Ham applied a spit mask on Kearney to stop him from spitting on us or the paramedics.

Kearney was taken to Lower Keys Medical Center by Rescue 2. I rode in the ambulance with the paramedics. We arrived at Lower Keys Medical Center, Kearney was medically evaluated and medically cleared. Ofc. Roscoe arrived and we placed Kearney in the back seats of Ofc. Roscoe's vehicle without incident.

My AXON BWC was activated during this incident.
