On 6/1/2021, at about 0140 hours, I (Ofc. Nick Dantu) assisted Ofc. Andrew Hudson at the corner of Greene Street and Duval Street. This was about a physical disturbance.

When I arrived, I saw Ofc. Hudson speaking with a female person, (Alicia Veliz). Ofc. Randy Perez arrived on scene.

Security personnel from Rick's bar at 202 Duval Street told me that Alicia was involved in a physical incident with another female person, (Stacy Mize). I located Stacy on the 100 block of Duval Street. Stacy's nose had been bleeding and there was dried blood in both nostrils. Stacy told me that she walked out of Rick's bar and began walking South on Duval Street. Alicia walked up to Stacy and punched Stacy in the face, (nose). I asked Stacy if she needed medical attention. Stacy said she was fine and did not need medical attention. Stacy did not wish to press charges against Alicia.

I spoke with Ofc. Hudson who told me that Alicia was claiming that she was struck by Stacy.

I walked over to Alicia who was standing in the street and yelling at people on the sidewalk. I did not see any visible injuries to Alicia's body. I asked Alicia if I could speak with her. Alicia began to yell at me and state that I was not going to do anything to help her. I tried to engage in a conversation with Alicia but Alicia would not listen to me or allow me to speak. Alicia continued to yell at me and people on the sidewalk. Alicia began to walk to the middle of the street and continued to yell. I tried once again to engage in conversation with Alicia. Alicia was having none of it and continued to yell and cause a scene. I was unable to communicate or obtain any information from Alicia. Alicia was angry and her demeanor was becoming aggressive. (Alicia was walking back and forth in the street yelling, (cursing) at me and people on the sidewalk.)

I decided to detain Alicia and place Alicia in my patrol vehicle. I attempted to put handcuffs on Alicia. Alicia began to stiffen her body and attempt to pull her arms away from me. Ofc. Hudson assisted me in handcuffing Alicia. Alicia continued to try and pull her arms away from me and Ofc. Hudson. Ofc. placed Alicia's left hand into a handcuff. Alicia continued to resist by pulling her right hand away from me. I was able to gain control of Alicia's right hand/wrist. Alicia began to kick her legs out from under her. Ofc. Hudson and I advised Alicia not to resist. Alicia continued to resist. Alicia kicked Ofc. Hudson in his upper front thigh area. Ofc. Hudson displayed his taser. Ofc. Hudson, to get Alicia to comply, drive stunned Alicia to her lower left back area. Alicia complied. I handcuffed Alicia's right wrist.

Ofc. Hudson and I assisted Alicia to my patrol vehicle. I placed Alicia into the back of my patrol vehicle. Alicia continued to yell and would not allow me to engage in conversation.

Ofc. Hudson did not need medical attention and KWFR was not called to the scene.

Ofc. Hudson advised dispatch that his taser had been deployed and contacted Sgt. Alex Rodriguez at 0149 hours.

Sgt. Alex Rodriguez arrived on scene and spoke with Alicia.

I decided to arrest Alicia under section 784.07-2B, Florida Statutes: Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer. Based on the facts and evidence in this case there is probable cause to believe that Alicia on 6/1/2021 at about 0140 hours did intentionally touch or strike a police officer/law enforcement officer, (Ofc. Hudson) against his will; Alicia knew that Ofc. Hudson was a law enforcement officer/police officer; and Ofc. Hudson was engaged in the lawful

performance of his duties when Alicia committed the battery.

I decided to arrest Alicia under section 877.03, Florida Statutes: Disorderly Conduct / Breach of Peace. Based on the facts and evidence in this case there is probable cause to believe that Alicia, on 6/1/2021, at about 0140 hours, corrupted the public morals, outraged the sense of public decency and affected the peace and quiet of persons who may have observed the act. Alicia was also encompassed in brawling and fighting.

I decided to arrest Alicia under section 843.02, Florida Statutes: Resisting an Officer without Violence. Based on the facts and evidence in this case there is probable cause to believe that Alicia, on 6/1/2021, at about 0140 hours: resisted, obstructed, or opposed a law enforcement officer; at the time the officer was engaged in the execution of legal process or the lawful execution of a legal duty; the officer was a person legally authorized to execute process; and at the time, Alicia knew that the person resisted, obstructed, or opposed was in fact an officer or other person legally authorized to execute process.

I transported Alicia to Monroe County Detention Center.

Ofc. Perez photographed Stacy's injuries. A female staff member at Monroe County Detention Center photographed Alicia's lower left back area - (the area where Alicia was drive stunned). I uploaded the photographs to evidence.com

I uploaded my BWC footage to evidence.com

Ofc. Hudson uploaded his in-car camera to the Coban system

On 06/01/2021 at approximately 0137, while on routine patrol in the City of Key West, I was at the intersection of Green St and Duval St facing West when I observed a female in a black dress begin pushing another female. I activated my blue overhead emergency lights, moved my vehicle to the opposite side of the intersection, and made contact with the involved parties.

The female dressed in black, later identified as Alicia V. Veliz DOB 10/24/2000, began to walk away at which time I stopped her and brought her back to the front of my vehicle. Veliz stated the other female had started a fight with her and she was defending herself.

Officer R. Perez arrived on scene and stood with Veliz while I conducted a person's check.

Officer Dantu made contact with the other female.

Officer Dantu told me the other female involved stated she had been walking down the street when Veliz came up and began yelling at her. He said she told him that when she hit her and I arrived. Officer Dantu added she did not want to press charges for the battery.

Officer Dantu went to speak with Veliz, who was yelling profanities in the street. Officer Dantu attempted to take Veliz into custody for disorderly conduct when she began to pull away from him. Officer Dantu redirected Veliz onto the hood of my patrol vehicle in effort to gain control. I attempted to handcuff Veliz's left wrist when she lifted her left leg onto the hood of my vehicle and kicked me in my right thigh area; then in the left. I unholstered my agency issued Taser, removed the cartridge, and applied one full cycle drive stun to her left lower back area at which time Veliz began to comply.

Veliz was handcuffed behind the back with double lock engaged and placed in the rear passenger seat of Officer Dantu's vehicle.

Sergeant A. Rodriguez responded.

All of the above was captured on my in-car and bodyworn cameras, 3940.

Nothing further at this time.

On 06/01/2021, at 0137 hours, Ofc. Dantu and I (Ofc. R. Perez) were in route to Duval and Greene St. to assist Ofc. Hudson with a battery.

Upon arrival I see a female later identified by her Colorado DL as Alicia Veliz standing in front of Ofc. Hudson's vehicle crying hysterically. She points down the street and states they were the ones that hit me. Ofc. Dantu walked over to speak with two females that may have battered Veliz.

While I was standing with Veliz she began to say that nobody is going to believe her because we are all racist white cops. I explained to Veliz that we are conducting an investigation to find out what happened. Ofc. Dantu hands me a Georgia DL belonging to a Stacy Mize and asks me to check it on F/NCIC. As I am checking the license, I see Ofc. Hudson and Ofc. Dantu attempting to handcuff Veliz. I get out of my vehicle and attempted to help Ofc. Hudson and Ofc. Dantu. By the time I approached them they gained control of Veliz and she was placed in the back of Ofc. Dantu's marked patrol vehicle.

I gathered the information of a female identified by her Georgia DL as Stacy Mize. I also gathered the information of another female identified by her Georgia DL as Jennifer McMullin. McMullin also filled out a witness statement of the events that occurred earlier in the night. Both Mize and McMullin refused to press charges on Veliz. I forwarded the information to Sgt. A. Rodriguez and Ofc. Dantu.

My AXON BWC was activated during this incident.
