# REPORTING OFFICER NARRATIVE Key West Police Department Victim HOWELL, WILLIAM NEIL Date / Time Reported Thu 06/03/21 04:20

On Thursday, 06/03/2021 at approximately 0420 hours; Ofc. Hernandez and I (Ofc. Howell) were dispatched to 618 Caroline Street regarding an extremely intoxicated unknown male subject fighting with guests of the rental house and destroying property at the rental house.

I arrived on scene first. As I approached the property, I encountered a group of approximately four or five unknown subjects at the front door yelling, "He's upstairs! He won't leave! He's breaking furniture!" An unknown male subject, later identified as Bryan Tavarez (DOB: 10/31/1984, Victim) stated he was kicked in the face and the "guy" needed to leave the property immediately. As I walked upstairs, I encountered Jay A. Collins (DOB: 05/06/1985, Arrestee) standing at the top of the stairs with another unknown male subject. I asked Collins to identify himself however, Collins refused. The group that remained downstairs, pointed at Collins and positively identified him. I asked Collins to follow me down the stairs and outside, to speak with me in an attempt to deescalate the situation. Collins again refused and attempted to walk away from me. I followed Collins and instructed him to follow me downstairs. Collins refused and walked into a nearby bedroom. I immediately recognized that the bedroom was in complete disorder, broken furniture was laying all over the floor and bed, and the room was in complete disarray. An overturned mirror was laying on the bed and broken furniture pieces and glass were scattered all over the floor. As I reached towards Collins in an attempt to guide him out of the room, for officer safety, because I did not know if there were weapons in the room, Collins slapped my hand away. Collins began yelling obscenities at me and screaming that I could not arrest him. At this point, I told Collins to turn around and place his hands behind his back because he struck my hand. Collins became extremely irritated and pulled away from me. Collins took an aggressive fighting stance, closed his right fist, and struck me in the left temple and face. Although I was partially stunned from the initial impact of the closed fist strike and not knowing Collins intentions, I reacted and struck Collins in the left side of his face with my right hand. Collins fell on the bed and stopped attempting to fight with me. I placed Collins in handcuffs, and I noticed Collins was bleeding from his face. I immediately called for Key West Fire/Rescue over Key West Communications Channel 1.

At this point, Ofc. Hernandez arrived as by back up. Ofc. Hernandez and I removed Collins from the bedroom and placed Collins in the hallway, leaning against the wall. I asked Ofc. Hernandez to request a supervisor while collected myself and I continued to recover from the initial stun from Collins' strike to my left face and temple.

I received a small contusion above my left cheek, directly below my left temple, that was approximately an inch in diameter. The contusion was beginning to swell on scene. I was given a cold compress by Key West Fire/Rescue and cleared medically. Collins received a small laceration on his left cheek that was approximately half an inch in length. Key West Fire/Rescue treated and cleaned Collins injury. Collins was bleeding from the laceration however, Collins refused further medical attention and was cleared medically.

As Ofc. Hernandez and I escorted Collins to my patrol vehicle, Collins became upset that he was being arrested, yelling obscenities and that we could not arrest him. Ofc. Hernandez and I searched Collins subsequent to the arrest. Collins refused to sit down in my patrol vehicle and struggled with me and Ofc. Hernandez. Collins attempted to get out of my patrol car several times and placed his knee in the door, prohibiting Ofc. Hernandez from closing the door. Ofc. Hernandez was eventually able to push the door shut.

I transported Collins to the Monroe County Detention Center.

Ofc. Hernandez remained on scene to collect witness statements and speak with potential victims.

Ofc. Hernandez interviewed Tavarez and received a signed witness statement from Tavarez. The signed witness statement included that Collins began to "aggressively attack" his girlfriend, Hayley, "to the point she had to call for help." The witness statement included that Collins became frustrated that the group threatened to call the police and he kicked Tayarez in the left side of his face, with his right foot as Tayarez was walking up the stairs. The signed witness statement included that Collins fought with me, Ofc. Howell, after I arrived on scene.

Tavarez received a small quarter inch laceration to the right side of his bottom lip from Collins' kick. Tavarez also received a laceration on the right side of his chin, approximately a half inch in diameter, from Collins' kick. Tavarez stated both injuries had stopped bleeding before Ofc. Hernandez and I arrived. Tavarez refused medical attention.

Ofc. Hernandez interviewed and received a sign witness statement from Alycia D. D'Amato (DOB: 06/25/1988, Witness). The signed witness statement included that D'Amato was awoke to Collins screaming obscenities at his girlfriend and becoming irritated to the point of striking her across the face very hard. The signed witness statement included that D'Amato immediately called for Tavarez to help her and Collins girlfriend, at which point Collins kicked Tavarez in the face. The signed witness statement included that D'Amato closed herself in her room and called the police. D'Amato was unharmed throughout the encounter.

Ofc. Hernandez attempted to interview Collins' girlfriend, Hayley. Ofc. Hernandez stated she was also extremely intoxicated and refused to cooperate with his investigation. Ofc. Hernandez stated she would not provide a full name or date of birth and stated she was not interested in following through with charges against Collins.

Ofc. Hernandez took photographs of Tavarez's injuries. Ofc. Hernandez uploaded the photographs to Evidence.com. Ofc. Hernandez placed the signed witness statements in Key West Records Department.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 06/03/2021, Jay A. Collins Jr. did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 784.07-2B Battery on LEO, by actually and intentionally striking me in the left side of my face and temple, while I was engaged in my legal, lawful duties as a uniformed law enforcement officer.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 06/03/2021, Jay A. Collins Jr. did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 843.02 Resisting without Violence, by actually and intentionally struggling to and sit down in my patrol vehicle and attempting to block Ofc. Hernandez from closing the door of my patrol vehicle while Ofc. Hernandez and I placed Collins in my patrol vehicle, while we were engaged in our legal, lawful duties as uniformed law enforcement officers.

Based on the facts and evidence, I believe there is probable cause that on 06/03/2021, Jay A. Collins did knowingly and intentionally violate F.S.S. 784.03 Battery, by actually and intentionally kicking Bryan Tavarez in the left side of his face, against Tavarez's will and attempting to cause Tavarez bodily harm.

Collins appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. Collins's speech was slurred, and her eyes were bloodshot. Collins's breath had the odor of alcoholic intoxicants.

My BWC was activated for the encounter, arrest, and subsequent search of Collins. My In-Car AXON was activated for the transport of Collins to Monroe County Detention Center. I uploaded the videos to Evidence.com.
