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On 06/20/2021, at 2039 hours, Ofc. Ane and I (Ofc. R. Perez) were dispatched to 631 Greene St. in reference to a large group of people fighting. While in route I was advised that KWPD Dispatch was receiving several calls about the fight.

Upon arrival I see two large groups of people, one group was helping a distraught woman stand up and the second group was holding back a male later identified as Carlos Rodriguez. I was approached by a several bystanders who pointed me toward a male later identified as Antonio Rodriguez. The bystanders stated he punched several people in the group. I approached A. Rodriguez and placed him in handcuffs and attempted to walk him toward my vehicle so I could speak with him. I was then surrounded by females from both groups and they began to push me away and stop me from detaining A. Rodriguez. I was then approached C. Rodriguez who began to scream this is my brother and attempted to stop me from detaining A. Rodriguez. I gave the group loud verbal commands to step away from me and to let go of A. Rodriguez. The group refused to follow my commands. I asked advised over the radio that I needed other officers to assist with the large group.

Sgt. Sims arrived on scene and assisted me with separating the group from A. Rodriguez. I walked A. Rodriguez over to the street and had him take a seat on the curb. C. Rodriguez began to scream and call me homosexual slurs in Spanish. C. Rodriguez was clenching his fists and approaching me in an aggressive manner as I tried to detain him. C. Rodriguez was holding a sandal in the air and moving it in a manner that made me believe he was going to strike me with it. I made several attempts to detain C. Rodriguez and he kept pulling away from me. Sgt. Sims deployed his TASER striking C. Rodriguez in the back (see Sgt. Sims' supplemental report.) C. Rodriguez was placed in handcuffs. C. Rodriguez continued to call Sgt. Sims and I homosexual slurs in Spanish.

Ofc. Wynn arrived on scene and provided scene security. While Sgt. Sims and I were detaining C. Rodriguez, a male later identified by his Florida DL as Jorge Martinez Ramos continued to interfere and approach us in an aggressive manner. Ofc. Wynn detained Martinez Ramos to stop him from interfering. (see Ofc. Wynn's supplemental report.)

Ofc. Ane arrived on scene and spoke to a witness later identified as Peter Scott. Scott stated a waitress saw a large fight taking place and she reported it to him. Scott told the waitress to call 911 and he walked outside to see what was taking place. Scott stated the fight was out of control and violent. Scott agreed to fill out a witness statement form.

Upon inspection of C. Rodriguez, A. Rodriguez, and Martinez Ramos they all had injuries on their faces and bodies that were indicative that they were involved in a fight.

Ofc. Wynn, Ofc. Agleev and I transported the suspects to the station to avoid further conflict with the remaining family members. The suspects were loaded in the KWPD transport van, in separate holding areas to avoid them reengaging in a fight. I transported the three suspects to the Monroe County Detention Center without incident.

Based on the facts and evidence, I have probable cause that on 06/20/2021, Carlos Rodriguez did knowingly and intentionally engage in conduct (fighting) that corrupted public morals, outraged the sense of public decency and affected the peace and quiet of persons who witnessed his actions, violating F.S.S. 877.03 disorderly conduct. Furthermore, Carlos Rodriguez also interfered in the lawful execution of my legal duty by pulling away and pushing my hand away while I attempted to arrest him violating F.S.S. 843.02 resist officer without violence.

Based on the facts and evidence, I have probable cause that on 06/20/2021, Antonio Rodriguez did knowingly and

intentionally engage in conduct (fighting) that corrupted public morals, outraged the sense of public decency and affected the peace and quiet of persons who witnessed his actions, violating F.S.S. 877.03 disorderly conduct.

Based on the facts and evidence, I have probable cause that on 06/20/2021, Jorge Martinez Ramos did knowingly and intentionally engage in conduct (fighting) that corrupted public morals, outraged the sense of public decency and affected the peace and quiet of persons who witnessed his actions, violating F.S.S. 877.03 disorderly conduct.

My AXON BWC was activated during this incident. During the incident someone or something bumped into my BWC causing it to shut off. I reactivated my BWC as soon as I realized that it was shut off.

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On June 20, 2021 at approximately 2043 hours I, Officer Agleev, responded to 631 Green Street (Conch Republic Seafood), reference a physical disturbance (see KYPD case 21-3261).

Upon arrival I observed a Hispanic male, later identified as Carlos Rodriguez, sitting on the ground already in handcuffs next to Sergeant Sims. Several officers were dealing with other suspects. Per Sergeant Sims' request, I transported Rodriguez to the KYPD Station. At the station Rodriguez was checked by medical personnel, reference having been tazed. I assisted with relocating Rodriguez to KYPD transport van. Rodriguez along with two other arrestees was subsequently transported to the Monroe County Detention Center.

My BWC and Fleet-In-Car were activated and uploaded to Axon Evidence.

On June 20, 2021, at approximately 2041 hours, I (Ofc. N. Wynn) was dispatched to 631 Greene St. (Conch Republic Seafood) in reference to a Physical Disturbance.

Key West Communications received multiple 911 calls in reference to a large group of people, estimated at up to 20 individuals, fighting in front of the restaurant. When I arrived Sgt. Sims had already used his taser on one of the suspects, and that suspect was lying face down and under control. Ofc. R. Perez was breaking up the crowd when I arrived. Behind and to the right of Sgt. Sims, another male, later identified as Jorge Martinez Ramos, was approaching Sgt. Sims and taking an aggressive position. Ramos was yelling at Sgt. Sims and possibly the subject on the ground. When Ramos would not back away I displayed my taser and activated it, but did not fire. Ramos began to back away. When I cleared Ramos from the immediate area I had him sit down and I placed him in handcuffs, making sure they were double-locked. Ramos had a fresh scrape, approximately three inches long, across his left shoulder, indicating that he had likely been in the initial fight. Once the scene was completely secured I escorted Ramos to my patrol car, where I searched him and secured him in the back. I transported Ramos to the Key West Police Department station, where he was transported to the department van to be taken to Monroe County Detention Center.

This incident was recorded on my BWC. The transportation of Ramos to the Key West Police Department station was recorded on my in-car COBAN.

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On 06.20.21 at about 2040 hours, Key West Police Dispatch began to receive multiple 911 calls about a large fight. Callers reported 15-20 persons were engaged in some sort of physical fight and that police were needed. Ofc. R Perez was the first officer on scene, and we received more 911 calls saying the officer needed help.

Ofc. R Perez was the first officer on scene and from what I understand, he was able to secure one person. I could hear him on the radio requesting that his backup expedite. I noticed a significant difference in Ofc. R Perez's voice inflection and speech pattern. He spoke in a higher than normal pitch and he talked really fast. I knew something was not right and was certain he needed the backup to expedite. I was near the location, coming down Lazy Way Lane.

When I got on scene, I saw well over 150 people in the area. Some were standing around the outer area watching what was going on closer to the entrance of the Conch Republic Seafood Company. The others were clustered near the entrance. Based on Ofc. R Perez's radio transmission, I grabbed my OC SPRAY, and began to run over to where I thought he was (in the middle of the cluster).

I could not make out what anyone was saying. There was a lot of yelling and screaming, and most of it was in Spanish. A group of several people (men-women-children) were pushing a Hispanic male back. I looked at this male and saw something was not right with him. His eyes were wide open, and the whites of his eyes were like paper plates. He had a very aggressive and threatening posture about him. He was yelling and screaming at the top of his voice (in Spanish). He was throwing his hands in the air, clenching/balling his fist, widening his stance, and trying to push back against those pushing him. I have no clue where he was going or what he was trying to do.

I got in between Ofc. R Perez and this crowd. This went on for several seconds until the male took a few steps back and to the side, in a valiant attempt to going around those holding him back. I did not know his role in this fiasco, but figured he had something to do with it based on his actions. Ofc. R Perez came toward me, but I was not able to understand what he said because of the crowd. Meanwhile, we were waiting on other units to respond to our location. The male got away from the crowd and was walking to my right. There were two females trying to hold him back. He continued with his rant, to which I could not understand most of.

Finally, I was able to ask Ofc. R Perez if this male needed to be taken into custody. He said yes and at some point, grabbed the males left arm/shoulder. I could see the male was holding a sandal or flip flop in his right hand. He turned his body slightly to the right, then back to the left, pushing Ofc. R Perez slightly. I had already taken mt TASER out and armed it. The male continued yelling at me, while Ofc. R Perez was giving commands to him in Spanish.

I made the decision to TASER the male. The TASER deployed and the probes struck him in the upper back on his right side. The male immediately turned toward me and then fell to the ground. He had a look of bewilderment in his eyes

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when he looked at me. The TASER did achieve nuero-muscular incapacitation. The male landed on his side and he rolled over onto his stomach. I kept telling him to put his hands behind his back, and he told me he did not speak English (but answered me in English). Eventually I pointed to his lower back, touching it, and he moved his hands there. He was eventually handcuffed without further incident, rolled onto his side, and put in a seated position.

I put on a pair of gloves and removed the probes according to how I was trained. The probes were inverted into the cartridge, with the wire wrapped around it to help secure the probes. I also collected a blast door and one of the AFIDS. I took a couple of pictures before removing the probes. However, Ofc. R Perez took pictures of the males back after we arrived at the station and after he had been checked over by rescue. It should be noted I am one of the Key West Police Departments primary TASER instructors, having helped implement the TASER program, and drafted a TASER policy.

The subject was later identified as, Carlos A Rodriguez DOB 0610.89, by his Florida driver's license.

Carlos displayed the following actions: active resistance- which was him turning away from Ofc. R Perez and then turning back toward him, pushing him slightly, all while holding a flip flop or sandal in his right hand. I responded with the following officer response option: non-lethal weapons: TASER w/TASER CAM- it was deployed with the cartridge on, with the two probes striking Carlos in the upper back on the right side. I did achieve nuero-muscular incapacitation. Carlos did not have any other injuries from being TASED or falling to the ground.

By this time another male had been arrested. Based on the volatile crowd and situation, I told all officers to re-group at the station. This was done to eliminate any more potential conflicts with family or friends of those who had been arrested. At the station, the transport van was used to take all arrested parties to jail. Ofc. R Perez will be completing the required affidavits and report. I will complete my supplemental and start and RRI report to be reviewed by Lt. H Wood. All other officers on scene were told to complete supplements as well.

My BWC was not on my person when I went to this call. I had left it in the charger in the report writing room. TASER Cartridge# C4106PFXC and what I assume to be a matching cartridge (cannot read the serial number even with reading glasses on).The blast door was green, indicating a 25ft cartridge.

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On Sunday, June 21, 2021, at approximately 2039 hours, I, Ofc. Ane, responded to the the Conch Republic Seafood Company, 631 Greene Street, to assist officers with a large fight.

Upon arrival, I saw Sgt. C. Sims had one male in handcuffs and advised he deployed his TASER to take the subject into custody. I saw two other males were detained, so I began to assist with crowd control and gathering witness statements. All males that were detained on scene were later transported to MCDC.

I met with Peter Scott, who was the manager for the Conch Republic Seafood Company. Scott advised a waitress notified him that 10 to 15 people were fighting in front of the restaurant. Scott went and saw the fight, then went back into the restaurant and told one of his employees to call 911. I attempted to speak with original waitress who notified Scott, however, she had already left.

I collected a written statement from Scott and gave it to Ofc. R. Perez, who later placed it into KYPD Records.

I had no further involvement with this investigation.

This investigation was recorded via my department issued body worn camera, which I later uploaded to evidence.com.
