Subject:	Recreational Rental Vehicle Regulatory License

# Action statement:

Commission approval to increase the annual fees for recreational rental vehicle permit, effective immediately, from \$50.00 to \$150.00.

### Background:

Per F.S Sec. 166.221 Regulatory fees.—A municipality may levy reasonable business, professional, and occupational regulatory fees, commensurate with the cost of the regulatory activity, including consumer protection, on such classes of businesses, professions, and occupations, the regulation of which has not been preempted by the state or a county pursuant to a county charter.

Currently, the holder of a recreational rental vehicle permit (RRV Permit) may obtain a renewal of the permit each year on or prior to May 30th by applying to the licensing office and submitting the following information: copies of registrations for each permitted unit, an annual business tax receipt fee of \$213.00, a regulatory license renewal fee of \$50.00 per recreational rental vehicle business, plus \$1 per unit. An annual inspection by the Code Compliance Department is required each year before the renewal of the regulatory license.

The approval of the regulatory fee increase will help with the administrative costs related to the task of issuing this regulatory license and ensuring annual compliance. It is staff's observation that the City needs to recover a portion, not all, of the costs of providing these services to the citizens. Staff also recommends fees are annually increased by 5%, to become effective on October 1, 2022, and each year thereafter, until or unless amended by Resolution of the City Commission. Along with this change, Staff also recommends increasing the RRV permit fee fees from \$50.00 to \$150.00 effective immediately, until or unless amended by Resolution of the City Commission.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

The Licensing Official proposes the City Commission adopt a resolution increasing the recreational rental vehicle regulatory licensee renewal fee from \$50.00 to \$150.00 effective immediately.
