- 2. Smathers Beach Debra Yates' Mosaic Wall Paperwork complete, artist will make arrangements to do all restoration and repairs in November.
- 3. AIPP Ordinance review Marianne and Liz set forth as an action item today to revise ordinance for City Commission approval.
- 4. Private/Public CHI Health Clinic at Douglass Band Room (CKW property) Waiver was denied for CHI Health Clinic at July 20 Commission meeting. Project opening delayed due to supply issues. Working with Clinic staff to fulfill 1% for art.
- 5. **Collections Management** Ongoing. Will work with City staff and Michael Marrero to update City collection/inventory app ready to go, need to work with each board member.
- 6. **1400 Duval Park/Mall** Ongoing. No further updates on the signage for the park will be working with HARC, Commissioner Hoover, Rosi and Parks & Rec Board.

- 8. **Douglass Gym Expansion** Ongoing. No further updates this item may be on the July 20 City Commission meeting. BVRAC approved revised plans at their May 6 meeting, going next to HARC/City Commission for approval.

Discussed with Finance Director Mark Finigan proper valuation of the artwork, and how to properly handle the financial contribution from the Patrons for installation and maintenance. I will write up executive summary for City Commission for the September 1st meeting for approval.
