-- Stephen Lewis Narmour Arrest Narrative:

On Tuesday, 06/29/21, at approximately 2015hrs, I (Ofc. T. Clark), while on routine patrol of the intersection of College Rd and Overseas Highway, observed a subject drinking from an open alcoholic beverage in a public place.

BWC activated

The subject, known to me from previous arrest and warnings as, Stephen Narmour 01/03/61, was seated just off the public sidewalk drinking from a clearly marked Hurricane High Gravity Beer, 16 FL OZ, 8.1 ALC/VOL.

Stephen exhibited slurred speech, glassy/watery/bloodshot eyes and the overwhelming odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath.

The beverage was half consumed, cold to the touch, contained and amber liquid and when poured out foamed. The beverage smelled strongly of an alcoholic beverage.

I have arrested Stephen and warned him in the past for open container.

When I advised Stephen he was under arrest he became defiant. Stephen attempted to leave during the course of my investigation. I advised Stephen he was not free to leave. I gave Stephen numerous warnings not to resist my attempts to place him under arrest as he attempted to leave the scene. When I grabbed Stephen as he attempted to flee, he pulled away from my grasp, numerous times. Stephen disobeyed my lawful orders and set himself on the ground in defiance.

Stephen attempted to crawl away from me. I grabbed Stephens right wrist as he disobeyed lawful orders to place his hands behind his back. Stephen twisted and pulled his arm away from me and attempted to stand and escape custody. I used a controlled take down, while holding Stephens right wrist, to the ground, from a waist high height.

Once, laying on the ground he continued attempting to escape and disobeying numerous lawful orders. I placed Stephen in a three point pin, and using pain compliance on his right wrist, was able to secure him in handcuffs.

During our struggle, Stephen suffered a small laceration above and below his right eye. I requested Sgt. F. Sims respond to complete a Response to Resistance Incident. I also requested EMS respond to treat Stephens injuries.

EMS responded and transported Stephen to LKMC ER. Once there he was treated for his injuries and received a medical clearance.

I transported Stephen to jail without incident.

Due to the totality of the circumstances, I found probable cause to charge Stephen with open container in a public place, for drinking from an open clearly marked beer.

I also found probable cause to charge Stephen with resisting arrest without violence, for disobeying numerous lawful orders and attempting to evade arrest (pulling/twisting/fleeing).

This case is cleared by arrest.//

My body camera was not active at the time of the incident as it was inside the Key West Police Department uploading. My in-car video captured my response and initial interaction with the subject, 3940.

On 06.29.21 at approximately 2021 hours, I, Sgt. Carter Sims, responded to the area of US1 and College Road. This was reference a request by Ofc. T Clark, because he was involved in an RRI while taking a subject into custody.

Ofc. T Clark had requested backup over COMM1, then requested the responding unit ot expedite. Ofc. A Hudson was the responding backup officer. Ofc. T Clark had already handcuffed the subject and put him the back of his car. In addition, Ofc. T Clark had requested KWFR to respond becuase the subject was injured in this incident.

I responded to the above location to investigate what had taken place. When I arrived, KWFR was on scene and preparing to transport the subject to the ER for additional treatment. This subject was later identified as, Stephen Narmour DOB 01.03.61. I stopped briefly to make sure everyone was alright and then continued onto the ER, to wait the arrival of KWFR. Ofc. A Hudson rode in the ambulance and Ofc. T Clark drove himself there.

At the ER, I made sure Ofc. Clark was ok and not injured. He confirmed he was not injured. However, he said his pride was hurt. He was already working on downloading his BWC in car. I watched a portion of the video.

In the video, I could see Ofc. T Clark approach Narmour, make contact, and tell him he was under arrest for OPEN CONTAINER. Narmour immediately became defiant and resisted Ofc. T Clarks request to comply with his lawful orders. The video clearly shows Narmour standing up and attempting to walk away; he pulls his arms away; he throws himself to the ground; trys to crawl away and stand up; and Ofc. Clark holding Stephen`s right arm and pushing on his upper back. Stephen goes to the ground from a kneeling position and is eventually taken into custody with further incident.

I spoke with Narmour outside of the ER. He did not think it was fair he was being arrested and that he did nothing wrong. I explained to him what was going to happen, and he began to argue with Ofc. T Clark for some unknown reason. Narmour said he really did not have a complaint about what had taken place, but was clear he did not resist. The video clearly shows otherwise. I took some pictures of him using AXON capture and will later download them.

My BWC was activated on this call. It will be downloaded as well. I did not take part in this invstigation, merely responded for an RRI.
