## Action Statement

Ratify City Manager approved emergency change order in the amount of \$9,266.93 to Charley Toppino & Sons (CTS) in accordance with Code of Ordinances Sec. 2-845 (a).

### **Background**

Per Resolution 21-146 and the 2021 General Utilities & Infrastructure Services contract, CTS was issued a work order to install an ADA compliant sidewalk along 19<sup>th</sup> Street in the amount of \$106,819.39. During installation, an approximately 85' section was set too high, causing access and drainage issues on a resident's property. An emergency change order was approved as crews, equipment and materials were on-site. CTS was directed to remove and replace the section at City cost as plan elevations for that section were unclear.

### **Financial Issues**

Change order is 8.7% of original contract, requiring Commission approval at the next scheduled meeting. The Work Order was funded from Account 102-4102-541-6300 (Project number II41022101, established for improvements in the right-of-way).

### **Recommendation**

Staff recommends ratifying City Manager approved emergency change order in the amount of \$9,266.93 to CTS in accordance with Code of Ordinances Sec. 2-845 (a).
