A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ATTACHED "AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO AGREEMENT NO. LP44031" BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) AND THE CITY OF KEY WEST TO EXTEND THE PERIOD OF AGREEMENT TO JUNE 30, 2022; AUTHORIZING ANY NECESSARY BUDGET AMENDMENTS OR ADJUSTMENTS; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 17-124, the City Commission approved an FDEP Agreement for Federal funding for Key West Stormwater Improvements, in Resolution 18-047, the City Commission approved Change Order No. 1 to the Agreement, and in Resolution 19-040, the City Commission approved Amendment No. 1; and

WHEREAS, Amendment No. 2 authorizes additional time to complete the Grant Work Plan and close out the grant, due to COVID-19 related delays; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF KEY WEST, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the attached "Amendment No. 2 to Agreement No. LP44031," between FDEP and the City is hereby approved, to extend the period of agreement to June 30, 2022.

Section 2: Grant funds are already budgeted for this project, and this Amendment represents a no-cost time extension.

Any necessary budget amendments or adjustments are hereby authorized.

Section 3: That the City Manager is authorized to execute any necessary documents, upon advice and consent of the City Attorney.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall go into effect immediately upon its passage and adoption and authentication by the signature of the Presiding Officer and the Clerk of the Commission.

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AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO AGREEMENT NO. LP44031 BETWEEN FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AND CITY OF KEY WEST

This Amendment to Agreement No. LP44031, as previously amended, (Agreement) is made by and between the Department of Environmental Protection (Department), an agency of the State of Florida, and the City of Key West (Grantee), on the date last signed below.

WHEREAS, the Department entered into the Agreement with the Grantee for City of Key West Stormwater Improvements effective May 17, 2017 and amended on February 12, 2019 and,

WHEREAS, the Grantee has requested a revision in the scope of work, and an extension of the Agreement which is needed due to COVID-19 related delays; and.

WHEREAS, certain provisions of the Agreement need revision.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. The Agreement is effective until June 30. 2022. The reimbursement period for this Agreement begins on July 1, 2016 and ends at the expiration of the Agreement. The Department and the Grantee shall continue to perform their respective duties during this extension period pursuant to the same terms and conditions provided in the Agreement.
- 2. Attachment A-1, Revised Grant Work Plan, is hereby deleted and replaced with Attachment A-2, Revised Grant Work Plan, as attached to this Amendment and hereby incorporated into the Agreement. All references in the Agreement to Attachment A shall hereinafter refer to Attachment A-2, Revised Grant Work Plan.
- 3. Attachment B-1, Revised Payment Request Summary Form, is hereby deleted and replaced with Attachment B-2, Revised Payment Request Summary Form, attached hereto and made a part of the Agreement. All references in the Agreement to Attachment B, shall hereinafter refer to Attachment B-2, Revised Payment Request Summary Form.
- 4. Attachment D-1, Revised Progress Report Form, is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with Attachment D-2, Revised Progress Report Form, attached hereto and made a part of the Agreement. All references in the Agreement to Attachment D, shall hereinafter refer to Attachment D-2, Revised Progress Report Form.
- 5. All other terms and conditions of the Agreement remain in effect. If and to the extent that any inconsistency may appear between the Agreement and this Amendment, the provisions of this Amendment shall control.

ATTACHMENT A-2 REVISED GRANT WORK PLAN

PROJECT TITLE: City of Key West Stormwater Improvements

PROJECT LOCATION: The Project will be located at the intersection of Dennis and Venetia Street within the City of Key West in Monroe County. Lat/Long (24.5545, -81.7785). See Figure 1 for a site plan.

PROJECT BACKGROUND: The City of Key West (Grantee) will construct a stormwater pump station to alleviate localized flooding in the low-lying neighborhood along Dennis Street, Venetia Street, and Blanch Street. This pump station, currently under design, will receive stormwater runoff from adjacent street drain inlets and will reduce ponding issues in the streets. A vortex separator with a high-flow diversion structure will be installed upstream of the pump station to separate debris from the stormwater runoff prior to entering the pump station wet well. A backup power generator will be provided to maintain pumping capabilities in the event of a power failure.

The proposed discharge location is via outfall to the Salt Ponds, through an outfall structure located on the Key West High School property.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Grantee will construct the stormwater pump station, vortex separator with diversion structure, install a backup power generator, and connect the force main to existing outfall or a new outfall structure.

The Grantee does not anticipate that the funding under this agreement will result in a fully completed project, so this agreement will cover a portion of the work.

TASKS:

Task 1: Construction

Deliverables: The Grantee will construct the stormwater pump station, vortex separator with diversion structure, install a backup power generator, and connect the force main to existing outfall or a new outfall structure in accordance with the construction contract documents.

Documentation: The Grantee will submit: 1) a signed acceptance of the completed work to date, as provided in the Grantee's Certification of Payment Request; and 2) a signed Engineer's Certification of Payment Request.

Performance Standard: The Department's Grant Manager will review the documentation to verify that the deliverables are completed as described above. Upon review and written acceptance by the Department's Grant Manager, the Grantee may proceed with payment request submittal.


Payment Request Schedule: The Grantee may submit a payment request for cost reimbursement no more frequently than monthly.

PROJECT TIMELINE & BUDGET DETAIL: The tasks must be completed by, and all documentation received by, the corresponding task end date.

Note that, per paragraph 4 of the agreement, authorization for continuation and completion of work and any associated payments may be rescinded, with proper notice, at the discretion of the Department if the Legislature reduces or eliminates appropriations. Extending the contract end date carries the risk that funds for this project may become unavailable in the future. This should be a consideration for the Grantee with this and future requests for extension.
