**Title:** An Ordinance of the City of Key West amending Chapter 122 of the Land Development Regulations, entitled "Zoning," Article IV, entitled "Districts," Division 8 entitled "Historic Neighborhood Commercial Districts," to create a new zoning district entitled the "Historic Neighborhood Commercial District Bahama Village Truman Waterfront" (HNC-4), providing amendments to Section 122-92, entitled "Future Land Use Map Designations and Zoning Districts," Section 122-1111, entitled "Table of Land Use by Districts," Section 122-1112, entitled "Table of Permitted and Conditional Commercial Retail Uses by Districts," and Section 122-1151, entitled "Size and Dimension," Providing for intent, permitted uses, conditional uses, prohibited uses, and dimensional requirements; Providing for residential density of up to 40 units per acre; Pursuant to Chapter 90, Article VI, Division 2; Providing for severability; Providing for repeal of inconsistent provisions; Providing for an effective date.
